## CANDIDATES FROM ABROAD

Candidates to the first grades who attended schools outside of the Polish education system in the 2023/2024 school year and who are not taking part in the recruitment process via the recruitment portal should submit:
$\checkmark$ application of admission to the first grade,
$\checkmark$ a copy of the final certificate or other document confirming completion of the 2023/2024 school year with the final grades along with a translation,
$\checkmark$ document certifying the completion of 8 years of education with a translation.
ADDITIONALLY, candidates for 1IB-MYP grades from $16^{\text {th }}$ to $29^{\text {th }}$ of May 2024 till 3:00 p.m. must submit a declaration of participation in the language competence test in the English language.

$\checkmark$ a copy of the final certificate or other document confirming completion of the 2023/2024 school year with the final grades.
If the foreign school will not issue the final certificate before July $5^{\text {th }}$, a copy of the last report with grades (for example for the first semester of 2023/2024 school year) must be submitted within the deadline along with an information when the copy of the final certificate will be submitted.

To all of the submitted documents, that were not issued in Polish or English language must be attached a translation.
If the translation was not made by a sworn translator, parent/guardian of the candidate should confirm that the translation made by them is consistent with the original document and provide it with a handwritten signature.
