General rules

Time of arrival

- 8.00 / 12.00 before large exams (Polish, English, mathematics);
- 8.15 / 12.15 before other examinations;
- dresscode: **formal** (layers recommended).

General rules

- Students are allowed to bring only authorized materials.
- Personal belongings must be left outside the examination room.
- Phones and watches of any type must be left in a designated box by the entrance.
- ID must be presented upon examiner's request.

Items allowed

- Approved calculators – where applicable.
- Transparent pencil cases.
- Small (max. 0,5 l) bottle of still water **without label**.
- Tissues (without packaging or in a transparent packing without label).
- Medication (if pre-authorized by the coordinator)
- Writing tools
 - Dark blue or black ink for answers.
 - Soft pencil for diagrams/graphs.
 - Ruler, eraser, sharpener.
 - Colour pencils – for geography only (not required).

Items not allowed

- Cheat sheets.
- Notes/handbooks.
- Gel pens.
- Highlighters.
- Scrap/rough paper.
- Electronic devices (except for GDC).
- Food/snacks.
- Drinks other than still water.
- Lucky charms.
- Non-transparent pencil cases.
- Bags/backpacks.
- Unauthorised medication.
- Other similar items.

Conduct of the examinations

Items not permitted

If you take any of the following items into an IB examination - *even by mistake* - you will be in breach of regulations and may not be eligible for a grade in the subject being examined.

If you do not understand these instructions, please contact your coordinator.



Electronic equipment

Note that this includes, but is not limited to, mobile phones/cellphones and any device that allows communication.

An approved calculator is permitted in certain examinations.



Wearable technology and all types of watches

Note that this includes, but is not limited to, smart watches, smart glasses, and wireless headphones.

Refreshments

Water is permitted at the discretion of the coordinator.

Materials provided by the school:

- basic bilingual dictionary Polish↔English – upon request during the examination (except for language A & B exams).

Adverse circumstances

Illness:

- Contact the coordinator immediately via Teams/Vulcan/Outlook.
- Arrange a doctor appointment.
- Obtain a medical certificate.
- Wait for the instructions from the coordinator.

Oversleeping / late arrival:

- Contact the coordinator immediately via Teams/Vulcan/Outlook.
- Don't decide against coming!
- Come to school ASAP.
- Follow the coordinator's instruction.

Entering the examination room

- Follow the teachers' instructions.
- Leave your personal belongings in a designated area outside the examination room.
- **Switch off** your phone and smartwatch, and leave them in a designated box.
- Take the assigned seat.
- **Remain silent.**
- Do not switch seats.
- Pray / meditate / focus / zone out while waiting for the examination to start.

During the examination

- Do not communicate with each other **verbally and nonverbally**.
- Do not **turn back** or **lean towards** other candidates.
- **Listen** to the instructions very carefully.
- If you need anything (additional paper, bathroom etc.), **raise your hand high** and wait for the teacher to approach you.

During the examination

- If other candidate disturbs you, report it to the teacher, not to the culprit directly.
- You can use bathroom during the entire time of the examination.
- Remember: bathroom breaks are **not stop-the-clock** breaks.
- Do not ask the teacher to explain/interpret the questions for you or to confirm the correctness of your answers.

Types of examination papers

- **Structured:** punched; sent to the IB; answers in the examination paper and in an answer booklet if more space required.
- **Semi-structured:** punched; sent to the IB; some answers in the examination paper and some in an answer booklet.
- **Unstructured:** not punched; not sent to the IB; all answers in an answer booklet(s).
- **MCQ** (multiple choice): paper 1a in sciences (except for CS); all answers on a yellow MCQ answer sheet; **no additional time** to transfer the answers from the examination paper.

Cover sheet

- Personalised, blue sheet.
- Separate for each paper.
- No cover sheet for MCQ.

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Academic misconduct

E.g.

- Bringing **unauthorized materials**.
- Communication with other candidates.
- Impersonation.
- Removing exam materials.
- **Continuing after being told to stop.**
- **Discussing exam content within 24 hours** with people outside the school.
- Attempting to obtain exam content beforehand.

Academic misconduct

Each of the actions mentioned will be reported to the IB and may result in failing the Diploma.

Ending the examination

- You are not allowed to finish your work during **first 60 minutes and last 15 minutes** of regular time.
- Follow the instructions given by the teachers.
- Order of assembling the papers:
 - 1.** cover sheet (except for MCQ), **2.** examination paper (structured and semi-structured), **3.** answer booklet(s).
- Each answer booklet must be signed (first and last name, session number in designated boxes).
- **Do not attach scrap paper!**

Ending the examination

- You **remain seated** until instructed by the teacher to leave the room.
- You remain **absolutely silent!!!** – the examination might be still in progress for other students (HL, time extension).
- If the examination (both papers where applicable) last **longer than 2 hours**, you collect your belongings and **quietly leave** the examination zone.

DO NOT TALK TO EACH OTHER IN FRONT OF THE EXAMINATION ROOM!!!

2-hours supervision time

- If the examination last less than 2 hours (e.g. Language B P2I, Mathematics SL), you remain under supervision:
 - **until 11.00** in the morning session
 - **until 15.00** in the afternoon session.

Between morning and afternoon session you are free to go.

2-hours supervision time

During 2-hours supervision time you are **not allowed to:**

- use communication devices (mobiles, laptops, smartwatches, tablets etc.) – even if offline,
- leave the designated area, e.g. go home, go outside, go the cafeteria),
- make noise (Polish matura & lessons in progress)

2-hours supervision time

You are **allowed** to:

- talk to other candidates,
- sleep,
- eat (no takeaways!!!),
- study paper notes/handbooks
- read paper book,
- practice yoga etc.

Stay in a designated area, be quiet, do not communicate with the outside world.

Diploma results

- **5 July (Sunday)** around **18.00** at school.
- 6 July, 15.30 on students accounts.

Mind that you can collect the results **personally** or via **authorized representative** (written letter of authorization required).

Please check the school's website for detailed information at the end of June.

Don't forget!

- **Request for results service** – Form sent 24.02.2026 via Outlook.
- For **UCAS/Optagelse/UNIAssisst etc.** – send **one form** with application number.
- **Italy** – ask me about legalization of the Diploma.
