

ORGANISATION OF THE LINGUISTIC COMPETENCE TEST IN ENGLISH for admission to Grade 1IB-MYP in the 2026/2027 school year at High School No. 5 in Wrocław ON 8 JUNE 2026 AT 10:00

1. Eligibility to sit the Linguistic Competence Test in English

Only the following candidates may take the English language proficiency test:

- Candidates who, by 15:00 on 29 May 2026, submitted an application via the recruitment portal and selected at least one 1IB-MYP recruitment group.
- Candidates arriving/returning from abroad who, by 15:00 on 29 May 2026, submitted to High School No. 5 in Wrocław both the declaration of intent to sit the test and the school admission application.

Candidates who submitted, by 29 May 2026, a declaration of intent to sit the test together with a copy of an opinion/statement issued by a psychological-pedagogical counselling centre (including specialist centres) confirming specific learning difficulties (dyslexia, dysgraphia, dysorthography) or a copy of a medical certificate may, based on the recommendations contained in the document, receive accommodations during the test, including an extension of the working time by up to 15 minutes.

2. Candidates must bring:

- a black or blue pen;
- a PHOTO IDENTITY DOCUMENT (school ID, national ID card, passport).
NOTE: Please prepare the document before entering the school building.
- optionally, a small bottle of water (0.5 l).

3. Candidates are kindly asked to arrive at the school building between 09:20 and 09:40.

Entry to the building is possible through three entrances:

- from Ślężna Street, next to the tram depot (MAIN ENTRANCE)
- from Jacek Kuroń Street, next to the car park (PARKING ENTRANCE)
- from J. Kuroń Street (SIDE ENTRANCE)

4. Upon entering the school building, candidates show a photo ID

and proceed immediately to the rooms indicated on the candidate lists. Boards with room numbers and corresponding candidate lists will be displayed at each entrance and on all floors.

NOTE: ONLY CANDIDATES MAY ENTER THE SCHOOL BUILDING. PARENTS ARE KINDLY ASKED TO REMAIN OUTSIDE.

5. Candidates enter the examination room one at a time, presenting their photo ID before entering the room.

The supervising teacher will draw the candidate's desk number in their presence and will provide the codes required to access the test results.

NOTE: PLEASE KEEP YOUR CODES UNTIL THE RESULTS ARE PUBLISHED.

TELECOMMUNICATION DEVICES

- The recruitment committee encourages candidates (if possible) to leave smartwatches and smartphones outside the school building.
 - Candidates who bring a device must switch it off.
 - Devices must be left in the designated area, labelled with a note showing the candidate's desk number. All labelled devices will be stored in specially designated rooms on the ground floor.
 - After finishing the test, the candidate collects their device and leaves the building immediately. Devices should only be switched on after leaving the building.
 - Using telecommunication devices during the test is strictly prohibited. Any use of such a device will result in the candidate's test being terminated and the result invalidated.
 - **Note:** Any activity of a device (ringing, alarm, notifications, etc.) in the examination room will be interpreted as use of a telecommunication device.
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6. At exactly 10:00, the candidate receives the test paper and the answer sheet and follows the instructions on the first page.

Test duration: **60 minutes** (or **75 minutes** for candidates with extended time).

7. Late candidates may be admitted to the examination room only until the completion of organisational procedures

(i.e., until the moment when the start and end times of the test are written in a visible place). After the organisational procedures have been completed, including after the distribution of test papers, late candidates will not be admitted.

8. Candidates should not leave the examination room.

In justified situations, the supervising teacher may allow a candidate to leave the room after ensuring conditions that prevent any contact with other persons.

9. Candidates may finish the test early and must signal this by raising their hand.

10. After finishing the test, the candidate leaves the test paper and answer sheet on the desk and exits the school building.

11. On Tuesday, 9 May 2026, by 14:00, the school website will publish the coded list of candidates who achieved a positive result.

Individual codes will be given to candidates upon entering the examination room on the day of the test.

NOTE: The test results will also be available in the recruitment system, on the candidates' individual accounts (this applies to candidates who submitted their recruitment application via the online portal by 15:00 on 29 May 2026).
